Coaching

Court schedule

The scheduled club sessions are as follows:

Club evening (adults and proficient juniors) from 6.30 p.m. – Starting 7th May Monday

Wednesday Club afternoon (adults) from 1.30 p.m.

Evening matches possible.

Club evening (adults and proficient juniors) from 6.30 p.m. also starts 7th May Thursday

Saturday Informal Junior Coaching: 9:30-11:00 (First Saturday of each month).

Adult Club session, and informal coaching 10:30-1.00 every week.

Afternoon matches possible. All through the year, winter and summer.

Sunday Matches possible, both morning or afternoon. Check the calendar on our website.

Apart from those times, the courts are available on a first come first served basis, except when there are organised club events. The days may be subject to change, which will be advised on our website and notice board.

League matches and club events take priority over casual play, but we will do our best to give advance warning by putting notices on the club notice board. The match dates are also on our website www.purleyonthamestc.co.uk It's worth checking, as sometimes matches have to be rearranged.

Court care

Please help us to keep the courts tidy. If you notice any problems, please tell a committee member. The courts are strictly for tennis only, so if you see anyone using them for anything else, please ask them to stop.

Purley Sports and Social Club

Bar and Social Facilities available adjacent to the courts. To use these facilities you must be a member of Purley Sports & Social Club. Conversely, membership of the Purley Sports & Social Club does not entitle anyone to free use of the courts! We have negotiated a reduced membership to the social club of just £5 for the summer, ie 31/3 to 1/10; this will entitle us to use all their facilities, what a bargain. (And the drinks are cheaper for members too).

Casual use of the courts

The agreement with Purley Parish Council regarding the use of the courts by non-members is that one court should be available to non-members from the Parish when it is not needed for official Club sessions; a fee to the Tennis Club of £5 per hour is payable. Adult members - PLEASE HELP US! Wear your shoe tags yourselves, challenge (politely!) those without shoe tags and encourage them to pay when they play. Money may be taken to Colin Moses, Windy Nook, Westbury Lane, Purley, or given to any committee member.

Members' guests

Please note that the Club Rules state the following: "Members may introduce visitors who shall not be introduced more than three times in any period of 12 months on payment of the appropriate fee to the Membership Secretary." The guest fee is currently £3.
